Angelic Reiki. It is an important subject to  
explore deeper in our own personal study.

Question: Why, in Angelic Reiki, do we  
put one hand on the Solar Plexus and the  
other on the Higher Heart?

Answer: Because Angelic Reiki is the  
Healing for Our Time.

And vice versa. Try it. Whether one

wants to ask the question 'Why, in Angelic  
Reiki, do we put one hand on the Solar  
Plexus and the other on the Higher Heart?'  
OR 'Why do we claim that Angelic Reiki is  
the Healing for our time?', which ever one  
you want to put first it does not matter.  
The one is the answer to the other.

Anodea Judith shows the Solar Plexus  
develops in each of us between the ages of  
18 months and four years. It is at this stage  
that the personality or ego is formed.  
This period is when the young child is  
exploring its ability to place their will in  
the world exploring 'How can I affect the  
world around ME? What works? What will  
happen?'

In this process the structure of the  
separate ME is established and moulded.  
It is the stage popularly known as the  
'terrible twos' with the battle of wills  
between the parents and child.

Parent: Lets put the blue shoes on  
because it is raining.

Child: No, I want the red ones.

Need I say more?

If we had to narrow down all the  
'problems' in the world today to one  
simple issue it would be the imbalance in  
the Solar Plexus. The Solar Plexus is about  
autonomy, individuality, power/abuse of  
power, domination, bullying, victimization,

Earlier this year I was approached by a client who asked if I would be willing to perform healing on her brother, who was in a coma in an Intensive Care unit. His blood had been poisoned by an aggressive strain of strep bacteria, and his condition had rapidly deteriorated.

She first made an appointment to come and see me in person and by the time she got to me for her session, her family had already been informed that he might not make it, so it was immediately evident that I was her last hope for a 'miracle healing'.

I gently explained to her that any healing I did would be performed by the angels from the Divine perspective and so my intention was for the highest and best healing to be delivered without any human hopes or fears getting in the way. I would simply be there to hold the space for whatever needed to take place.

The angels totally supported me in that intention. Sometimes, as humans, it can be difficult to let go of the need to know whether a certain outcome will unfold. Especially when someone's life is at stake. We so desperately want to offer hope or give good news, but I knew in that moment that it was absolutely vital that I stay neutral and grounded in a space of total unconditional love and surrender to the angels.

I felt my client relax as I explained all this to her. It's as if she too had been given permission to let go of the need to control anything. And I knew that she understood completely that it wasn't her - or my - responsibility to 'save' her brother.

As I began my client's healing session, I was also guided to send distance healing to her brother in hospital and, at that point, my mind went totally blank and I found I was very easily able to let go and not try to see what was happening. In fact it was one of the easiest sessions I have ever done. The angels allowed me to mentally

abuse, fear, terror, helplessness, hopelessness sense of purpose, etc.

An Angelic Reiki Healing does help with mental, emotional and physical issues but the defining purpose of Angelic Reiki is Spiritual healing; The Healing for Our Time; The linking of the Solar Plexus with the divine/ higher/soul self.

There is not time to keep tramping down the path of improvement. step back and simply allow the healing unfold as it would. I felt held and supported, and I trusted that the absolute Divine and perfect outcome for all would unfold.

The next day, my client phoned to ask if I would come to the Intensive Care Unit to perform healing in person for her brother. My only other experience of performing a healing of this kind was when my grandmother passed over a few years ago. She has since visited me in meditation and explained that she is now a 'spiritual midwife' and helps souls transition from the other side.

I asked the family to gather round and again explained that we were simply holding the space for the most Divinely perfect healing to unfold. I invited all of the family members to place their hands lightly on his body and I observed the angels merging with every person in the room. In that moment, I felt my grandmother's loving energy behind me and I knew she was also helping to hold the space. Yet, even knowing of her role in spirit, I didn't jump to any conclusions about the outcome of this healing. I simply let go and I just felt so much love - love for the soul of this man lying unconscious before me, love for his family who had so

graciously invited me to assist in their time of great need, and who had offered such an open-hearted and kind welcome - even despite their palpable grief. I totally and utterly surrendered to unconditional love.

Again, my mind went blank. But I will never forget the feeling that came over me in that moment. Something changed in me that day. I never thought I would be able to describe death as a beautiful thing, but I really feel that, as the soul of this man passed over, he gave me a great gift. In that moment, a kind of purity emerged from within me and I can't help but think that perhaps an outworn part of me also chose to transition at that time. I wonder if perhaps he, too, helped to hold the space for me. In any case, I will never look at life the same way again.

As I left the hospital, I still didn't know what the outcome would be for that man, but the world around me looked different. Colours appeared brighter and I could see light shining from the eyes of every person I passed. It was like I could see the very light of their soul radiating from within.

I learned a few days later that he had

# Summer solstice to autumn equinox

time of reflection upon the emotions that have gone in to building this thing since last winter.

After releasing those emotions and tying up any loose ends, the sun moves into Leo in late July and we finally have the time of ripening. The growth of this baby is complete and now our energy is focused on birthing this new creation. It could be a business, a vegetable patch, or a new hobby. Ultimately, we are not giving birth to any of those things, what we are giving birth to is ourselves, year after year. The project is merely the vehicle to get us there.

After these past months of doing something new, we have become changed and this change is going to result in a whole new us come autumn equinox.

At this time on 1st August is the old festival of Lughnasadh, which in Christian times was commuted to Lammas (an old Anglo-Saxon word meaning 'loaf-mass') as it celebrates the wheat harvest or first fruits. Lughnasadh is an old Celtic festival which commemorated the death of the god Lugh's mother Tailtiu, who died clearing the plains of Ireland for agriculture. Lugh vowed to hold games every year in her honour. The games were organised in a similar way to the ancient Olympic games and involved ritual shows of strength.

Lammas/Lughnasadh represents the culmination of masculine side of the year. This was a time when people were very active in the world, as it coincided with the wheat harvest and lots of physical labour was necessary. Most of the winter festivals are very feminine, revolving around the hearth and home, with an emphasis on children and/or the elderly.

The summer festivals are the time of men. Lammas in particular is such a time, and up until recently was known as Men's Sunday in Ireland. It was a time of trading cattle or horses, making contracts (so marriages were also on the cards at this time) and generally demonstrating prowess. This still exists today. In July and August we often see horse fairs, tractor pulls and shows/fetes of different kinds, often including things like a Tug o' War, which harkens back to Lughnasadh being a time for a show of strength. Another custom from this time was known as 'Reek Sunday' when it was common to climb a mountain in pilgrimage, such as Croagh Patrick, in County Mayo, Ireland.

**H**igh summer is upon us once again, the land is lush and green, the sun is strong, and people seem a bit more cheerful and relaxed than usual. Just as we get used to this glorious liquid light energy, it starts to change.

Between the 21st to 23rd of June, the sun pauses its long steep climb for three days and then begins to wane and retreat from us, taking its light and heat with it. Summer solstice represents a crossing over period, and at this point of the year, when the sun is at its brightest, we turn and begin the journey back into darkness.

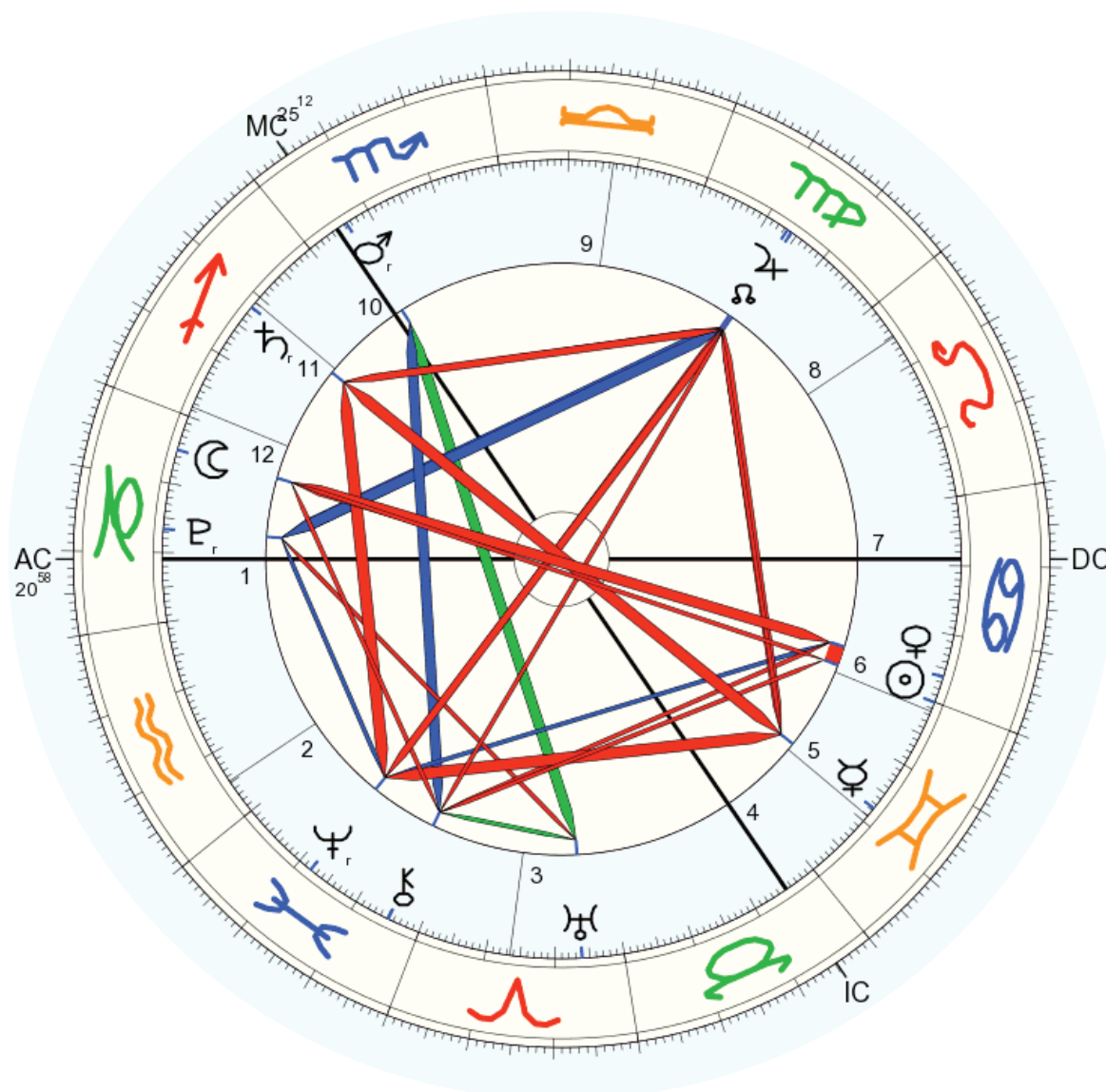
This theme of opposite energy is always prevalent in astrology and it is a good rule of thumb to consider the opposite sign when dwelling on any astrological energy. At this time of year, the bright light of high summer contains the seeds of darkness within it, as it marks the point of our return to it.

This yin and yang style flowing of energy explains why Winter Solstice is such a big deal in northern Europe, because it represented the energy of its opposite - the return of light. St John's or the Nativity of St John the Baptist is traditionally celebrated at summer solstice time. St John the Baptist was Jesus's second cousin, who prophesied the coming of Jesus as Messiah. So even the Christian tradition reflects how the Summer Solstice contains the seeds of the Winter narrative.

On a personal level, your projects of the year should be reaching their maximum growth potential. Summer solstice represents the end of growth, and preparation for a new phase of ripening. The rest of the summer should be spent in ripening that creation before it is ready to birth. In real terms this means fixing up any loose ends, etc.

Astrologically we are moving into Cancer, and as a Cardinal sign it represents a beginning. To use the pregnancy analogy, it would probably represent the move into the third trimester/six months period/30 weeks, whereby most of the pregnancy is past, and your mind begins to shift from actually being pregnant to being a parent to this child.

This time of Cancer, which is late June to late July, is a time to reflect on what has been created this year and what the process of doing that felt like. It is important to allow this time to be, as all that is released here will allow the next building period, which will commence at Winter Solstice to flow unfettered. It is a

traction). From Lughnasadh until Autumn Equinox is the time to reap your potential harvest for this year.

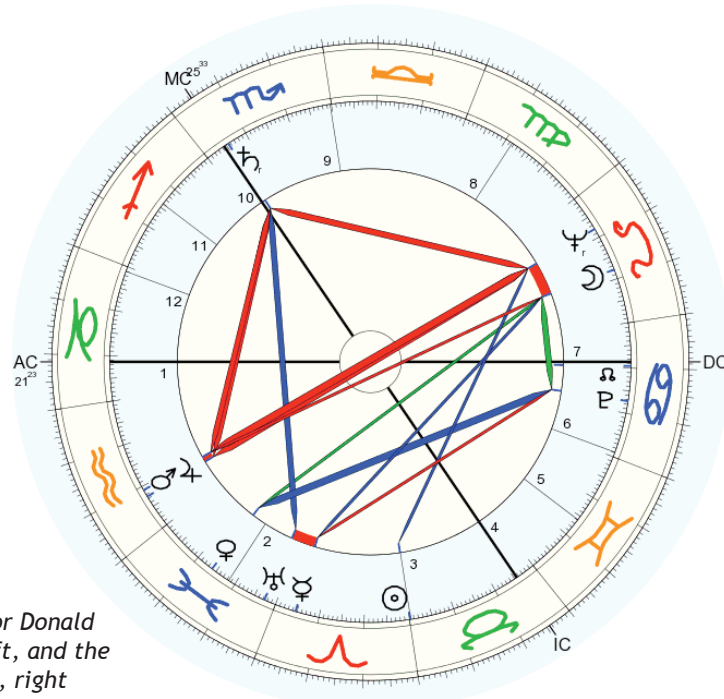
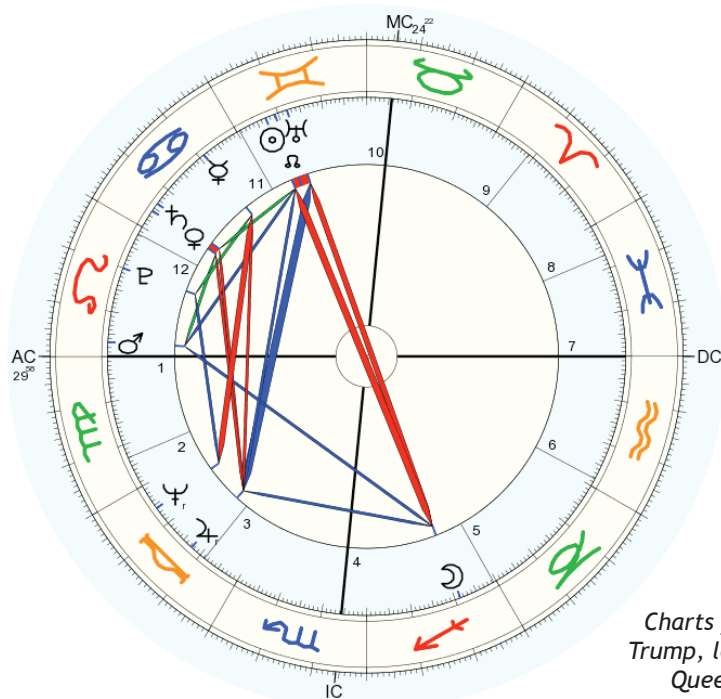

cross is like untying a big messy knot. There can be so many twists and turns of energy it is impossible to see where one is going. The key to get out of it is Saturn and Mercury as they are intercepted, so freer.

Mercury denotes, being creative with perception and thinking, using technology to think differently. Saturn is pompous and preachy in Sadge and in the 11th house represents the old mind set.

Mercury in the 5th supports the Cancer energy from the Sun. Neptune in Pisces in the 2nd on the south node shows we don't believe or value those old energy forms any more, they are empty and weak and do not feed us.
